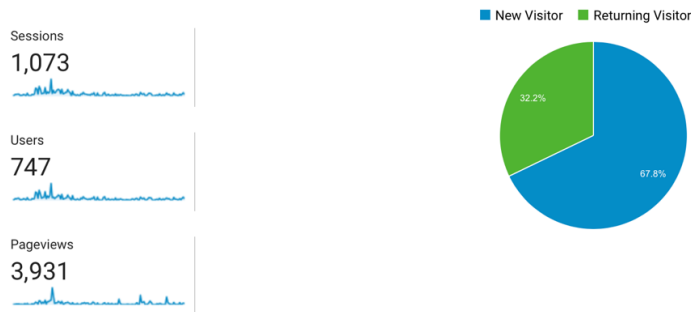

### New Business:


-April 2017, Special Issue on Economics Education, Guest Edited by Mary Beth Henning
